RE: Open Lunch Privileges  
DATE: September 2015

The Stamford Central School Board of Education passed a resolution stating that the senior class open lunch privilege can be suspended for any students failing one or more courses. In addition, student enrollment and participation in the open lunch program will be dependent on each individual's performance at the interim progress and quarterly marking periods. Students who are failing one or more classes at either point in time will have their open lunch privilege suspended. Likewise, any students who have improved their course grades so that they are no longer failing a class at the next five week point will have their open lunch privileges reinstated at that five week point.

## GUIDELINES FOR SENIOR CLASS OPEN LUNCH:

1. Participation will be with the written parent permission on school supplied form **ONLY**.
2. Pupils **WILL** sign in and out daily at the north end entrance.
3. Pupils **WILL NOT** be permitted to consume any drugs or alcoholic beverages.
4. Misconduct reported outside of school and confirmed by the administration as true will result in immediate cancellation of the privilege.
5. Truancy or failure to report on time will necessitate cancellation of this privilege. Students must return to school and enter the building before the end of their scheduled lunch period. Students who return to school before the end of their scheduled lunch period **MUST** report back to the cafeteria until the end of the class period. Honor Society students may report to the Honor Society room. Students are **NOT** permitted to roam/wander the hallways.
6. Serious or chronic misconduct, while in school, will result in immediate cancellation of the privilege.
7. Lack of preparation for class work or refusal to participate in classes without lawful excuse must be interpreted as misconduct and will necessitate termination of the privilege.
8. The Board has given the Superintendent complete authority over the administration of the program; and administrative judgment on cancellation of privileges will be final.

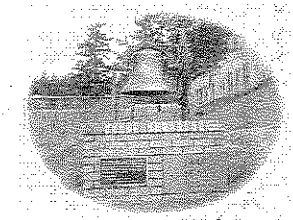
